SUMMARY:

The Commission is requested to authorize the Executive Director to approve two projects, G98005P187 and G98005P190, under the 2026 Green Solutions Program in a total amount not to exceed \$1,423,978. The 2026 Green Solutions Program funding was allocated in the approved 2026 Capital Budget.

The primary goals of this program are to contribute toward meeting the 50-million-gallon green infrastructure (GI) goal in the five-year Wisconsin Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit, continue progress toward the District’s 2035 Vision goal of providing 740 million gallons of GI capture capacity in any given storm by 2035, implement the Regional GI Plan, and support Commission Policy 1-01.14, Comprehensive Environmental Management. Additionally, this program helps to form mutually beneficial partnerships to further awareness of the importance of implementing GI to contribute toward a climate resilient community.

Approval of 2026 Green Solutions Program Projects G98005P187 and G98005P190

Dan Jansen Park Porous Pavement, submitted by City of Greenfield (G98005P187)

The project is installing a 25-stall porous pavement parking lot to serve the newly proposed pickleball courts at Dan Jansen Park. The project will install 7,635 square feet of porous pavement, capturing 22,905 gallons, and 12 trees, capturing 300 gallons.

Location: 4820 S 74th Street, Greenfield, WI

Gallons Captured: 23,205

GI Strategy: Permeable pavement and stormwater trees

2026 Green Alleys, submitted by City of Milwaukee (G98005P190)

The green alleys will be constructed as part of the City of Milwaukee's alley reconstruction project. The total amount of alley area that is removed and replaced is approximately 98,488 square feet, of which 20,576 square feet consists of permeable paver area. As part of the project, the entire length of the alleys will be excavated and removed to install the pavers in the center four feet of each alley, over a four-inch strip of bedding layer placed over a two-foot-deep storage area of #2 American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials stone. The stone will be installed to capture and store stormwater. Stormwater runoff from the adjacent land use, such as garages and surface runoff, will percolate through the pavers into the storage area.

Location: Eight Alleys in Milwaukee, WI, bounded by the areas bulleted below:

- West Fond du Lac Avenue, West Meinecke Street, West Wright Street, North 22nd Street, North 23rd Street
- West Greenfield Avenue, West Orchard Street, South 22nd Street, South 23rd Street
- West Fiebrantz Avenue, West Hope Avenue, North 62nd Street, North 63rd Street
- West Hopkins Street, West Townsend Street, North 22nd Street, North 23rd Street
- West Highland Avenue, West Juneau Avenue, North 26th Street, North 27th Street
- West Appleton Avenue, West Chapman Place, West Nash Street, West Potomac Avenue
- East Bradford Avenue, North Prospect Avenue, North Stowell Avenue, East Webster Place
- West Keefe Avenue, West Townsend Street, North 46th Street, North 47th Street
