## **BACKGROUND**

Authorizing the Executive Director to Execute a Change Order to Purchase Order 200017, Post Implementation Support of the Oracle Cloud Fusion Enterprise Resource Planning/Human Capital Management Systems

It provides prebuilt controls and a visual workbench for users to design and configure new rules, enabling organizations to rapidly implement best practices. Furthermore, RMC centralizes audit relevant data, streamlines compliance workflows, and facilitates collaboration across departments, transforming the audit process from reactive to proactive.

The benefits of implementing Oracle RMC can lead to reduced audit complexity, improved cybersecurity posture, and enhanced financial controls. By automating risk detection, continuous monitoring, and compliance activities, RMC can help the District to minimize manual effort, lower audit costs, and accelerate issue resolution.
