SUMMARY:				
The Commission is requested to authorize the Executive Director to execute on behalf of the District an intergovernmental cooperation agreement with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) for tree planting and to increase the total project cost (TPC) of Project W98006, Reforestation and Wetland Restoration (RWR), by \$300,000.				
The RWR program is a 15-year program through which approximately 6,000,000 trees will be planted and approximately 4,000 acres of wetlands will be enhanced or restored within the Greater Milwaukee Watersheds.				
WisDOT will be implementing the I-94 East-West Corridor Project between 2026-2032 and has committed under the project to spending \$300,000 as part of the District's RWR for planting trees in the Menomonee River watershed and Honey Creek watershed in Milwaukee County. The commitment is defined in the Supplemental Final Environmental Impact Statement, Record of Decision (ID 1060-27-03) (approved March 8, 2024). WisDOT funds will be reimbursed to the District as work is completed.				
The TPC of Project W98	006 will increase by	\$300,000 to reflect \	WisDOT's t	funding.
