## RESOLUTION

Settlement of Veolia Water Milwaukee's Claim of Uncontrollable Circumstances at South Shore Water Reclamation Facility in 2023

**RESOLVED**, by the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage Commission, that the Executive Director is authorized to execute a settlement with Veolia Water Milwaukee, LLC, in the amount of \$595,289 to resolve Veolia's claims for extra costs associated with alleged uncontrollable circumstances at the South Shore Water Reclamation Facility in 2023.
