RELATING TO: Settlement of Veolia Water Milwaukee’s Claim of Uncontrollable Circumstances at South Shore Water Reclamation Facility in 2023

SUMMARY:

The Commission is requested to authorize the Executive Director to execute a settlement with Veolia Water Milwaukee, LLC, (Veolia) in the amount of \$595,289 to resolve Veolia’s claims for extra costs associated with alleged uncontrollable circumstances at the South Shore Water Reclamation Facility (SSWRF) in 2023.

On January 29, 2024, Veolia transmitted a letter to the District claiming a total of \$1,266,879 in additional costs related to additional chemical costs – primarily disinfection chemicals – it incurred at SSWRF in 2023. Some of the costs counted as part of this claim were resolved previously; therefore, the final value of this claim by Veolia is \$1,190,577.

The District and Veolia have negotiated a resolution of \$595,289 in exchange for a full waiver of SSWRF disinfection chemical claims through January 2025.
