	Change Order Request to Purchase Order No. 10584, Material Capital Repair or Replacement Nos. 1125, Inline Storage System Dropshaft Site, NS12; 1147, Inline Storage System Dropshaft Site, NS09; and 1203, Diversion Chamber DC0705 Hydraulic Gate Cylinder Replacement, and Restore the Executive Director's Original Delegated Authority, Project C98055						
SUMMARY:							
The Commission is requested to authorize the Executive Director to execute a change order for purchase order (PO) No. 10584, Material Capital Repair or Replacement Nos. 1125, Inline Storage System Dropshaft Site, NS12; 1147, Inline Storage System Dropshaft Site, NS09; and 1203, Diversion Chamber DC0705 Hydraulic Gate Cylinder Replacement, with Veolia Water Milwaukee, LLC, (VWM) in an amount not to exceed \$69,719, and to restore the Executive Director's delegated change order authority, Project C98055.							
There are 24 dropshafts that control wastewater and stormwater flow into the Inline Storage System (Deep Tunnel). Each dropshaft site contains flow control gates that are operated by hydraulic cylinders.							
The NS09 dropshaft site contains two flow control gates and two hydraulic cylinders. One gate is used to control flow into the Deep Tunnel, and the other is a redundant backup gate. One hydraulic cylinder has failed, rendering its gate inoperable. A failure of the other hydraulic cylinder or gate could result in a combined sewer overflow should the gate fail to close-open or a tunnel overfill should the gate fail to open-close during a rain event.							
The Commission authorized issuance of PO 10584 to VWM to perform work on the NS09 dropshaft, along with similar work on the NS12 dropshaft site. The work at NS09 dropshaft consisted primarily of replacing the hydraulic cylinder that raises and lowers the gates. VWM had developed the scope of services, publicly bid, and entered a contract with Butters-Fetting Company to perform the work. VWM is responsible for managing this construction contract. After Butters-Fetting Company began work, several additional issues were discovered. Multiple parts had significant corrosion, were missing, or were improperly installed. The District and VWM recommend installation and replacement of the following components (that were not included in the original scope of work):

- One stainless steel stem rod.
- One stainless steel coupling.
- One thrust nut.
- Four stem guides.
- Two hydraulic isolation valves.

The Commission has delegated the Executive Director the authority to make changes to construction contracts up to a cumulative amount of \$50,000 for contracts that were originally less than \$500,000. To date the Executive Director has utilized \$47,020 of this authority, leaving a balance of \$2,980. The request to restore the Executive Director's authority is in case any additional construction changes beyond the remaining Executive Director's authority are necessary. Without this restored authority, work may need to stop while staff obtains necessary change order authority from the Commission.
